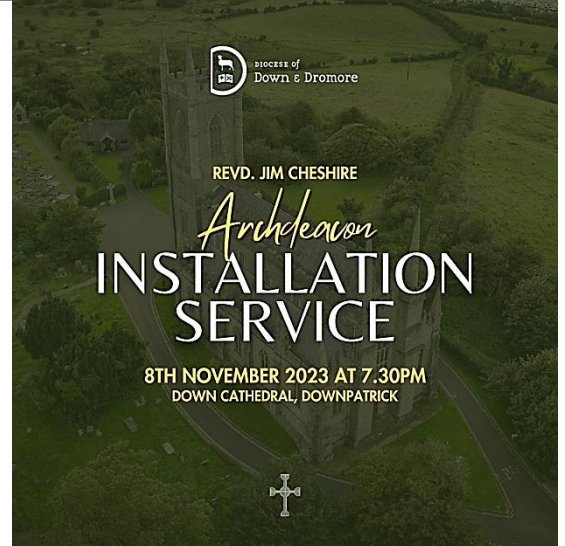


Bible Study
